Scholarships for Transfer Students

Transfer students are automatically considered for a transfer merit scholarship when they apply for admission to NIU. The amount of the merit scholarship depends on the student's cumulative transfer GPA:

- **3.50-4.00 GPA:** \$2,000 per year for two years.
- **3.25-3.49 GPA:** \$1,500 per year for two years.
- **3.00-3.24 GPA:** \$1,000 per year for two years.
